This brand new development offers one-bedroom homes within a 14 unit complex, each offering: main bedroom with built-in wardrobe, bathroom, kitchen and eating area, European laundry, lounge room and outdoor courtyard or balcony.

There are also well-appointed community and lounge areas, kitchen, meeting spaces and on-site overnight facilities for qualified and experienced around-the-clock support staff. Set in beautifully landscaped grounds, Haven Wodonga provides a great environment to focus on recovery, create a sense of community and to feel at home.

Owned by The Haven Foundation, specialists in providing quality social housing to people with mental health-related disability, this property is located in Wodonga and is close to public transport, local shops and other amenities.

Haven Wodonga was funded by Homes Victoria as part of the \$5.3 billion Big Housing Build and delivered in partnership with Mind Australia and The Haven Foundation.

- Are on or eligible for the Victorian Housing Register
