There are also well-appointed community and lounge areas, kitchen, meeting spaces and on-site overnight facilities for qualified and experienced around-the-clock support staff. Set in beautifully landscaped grounds, Haven Frankston Banksia provides a great environment to focus on recovery, create a sense of community and to feel at home.

Owned by The Haven Foundation, specialists in providing quality social housing to people with mental health-related disability, this property is located in Frankston and is close to public transport, local shops and other amenities.

Haven Frankston Banksia was funded by Homes Victoria as part of the \$5.3 billion Big Housing Build and delivered in partnership with Mind Australia and The Haven Foundation.

- Have an NDIS plan to fund housing support (flexible CORE or Supported Independent Living)
- Are on or eligible for the Victorian Housing Register
