

# Mental Health First Aid for the Suicidal Person

## A Mental Health First Aid (MHFA) course delivered by Mind Australia Limited

### Who is this course for?

This 4.5-hour workshop has been designed for adult members of the general public. It is not recommended for individuals recently bereaved by suicide.

### Course overview

This course teaches how to offer support to a person experiencing suicidal thoughts and behaviours. Suicide is a major preventable cause of death. Thoughts of suicide are relatively common, but they are not always acted upon. There are mental health first aid actions that any member of the public can take to reduce the risk of a person acting on thoughts of suicide. These actions can help to keep the person safe until a trained professional can assist them with any underlying mental health problems or other difficulties.

You will learn:

- about suicide rates and risk factors in the Australian context
- how to recognise the early-warning signs
- what to say and do
- practical skills to put into action
- where the person can get help
- how to make a safety plan.

Curriculum content is evidence based and has the input of mental health professionals, researchers and consumer advocates. Course participants receive a handbook and online certificate of completion. This training complements the 12-hour Standard MHFA course and the 14-hour Youth MHFA course.
