

Youth Mental Health First Aid (two-day course)

A Mental Health First Aid (MHFA) course delivered by Mind Australia Limited

Who is this course for?

This course has been designed for adults living or working with 10 to 19-year-old adolescents, such as: parents, guardians, grandparents, teachers, sports coaches, youth workers and youth resource officers.

Course overview

Mental Health First Aid teaches individuals how to assist someone who is either developing a mental health problem or is in a mental health crisis until appropriate professional treatment is received or until the crisis resolves. Learn the signs and symptoms, where and how to get help and what sort of help has been shown by research to be effective.

Mental health concerns covered include:

- depression
- anxiety problems
- psychosis
- eating disorders
- substance use problems.

The course teaches first aid for mental health crises which include:

- suicidal thoughts and behaviours
- non-suicidal self-injury
- panic attacks
- traumatic events
- severe psychotic states
- severe effects from alcohol or other drug use
- aggressive behaviours.

The course content, language and actions recommended are in accordance with international Mental Health First Aid Guidelines developed using the consensus of expert panels of mental health consumers, carers and professionals from developed English-speaking countries. The course uses updated statistical information on mental illness in Australia and incorporates the latest evidence on treatments and services available.
